The fee for a calendar year is DK 150 for individual membership and DK300 for family membership. An additional fee of DK 50 is charged for the initial enrolment.

### ☒ Ordinary Sleeping Membership

As there are many enquiries from Singaporean living out of Copenhagen wishing to join the Club, the committee decided to establish this type of membership so that members living out of Copenhagen area can maintain contact with the Singapore community here, and if they wish, can also participate in some of the events planned, if they happened to be in town.

A member in this category is entitled to receive our quarterly newsletter and the updated contact list. Whenever a Minister or delegation visits us, the member is most welcomed to participate as a paying guest as well. Fee in this instance is dependent on the venue and type of event arranged.

Sleeping membership fee is DK50 per year and is opened to only Singaporeans and Singapore PRs. Anytime at a later stage if the member should wish to convert to a full membership, they may do so. Enrolment fee in this case will be waived.
